I am pleased to announce the 7th EFIM Seminar on Clinical Research which will be held in Paris from 17 to 19 October (Residents arrive Sunday 16 October and depart Wednesday pm 19 October).

This enables us to offer bursaries to 15 young internists who are interested to develop their career in Clinical Research in Internal Medicine. If you are interested to attend in October, please return your application form as soon as possible with a short **2-3 page CV** including any publications and details of any research work that you have been or are currently involved in. We also require a free motivation statement (approx 150 words) to explain why you think the course will be valuable to you. This will help us in the selection process.

As the number of places is limited, we request that you only apply if you have NOT previously attended the seminar. This will allow others to take advantage of this important educational resource. We will award bursaries to the most suitable candidates from 15 different countries.

Note: Applicants must have good knowledge of the English language; be under the age of 35 years and be currently (or recently) involved in a clinical research project. All lectures and interaction will be in English.
