TRAINEE'S CRITERIA



The Exchange Programme intends to provide opportunities for gaining knowledge and skills for the Young Internists taking part. This is a chance to become more confident and self- reliant in professional life.

- This experience gives the Young Internists the edge in an increasingly competitive labour market and has a positive impact throughout their careers.
- This is a great opportunity to know each other better and understand the realities of other European countries.

- Speak fluent English.
- Completed the first two years of medical residency in Internal Medicine.
- Must have current and valid Health Insurance.
- Must have the support of their National Society.
- The resident should write a final report of the Exchange Programme in order to get the certificate and the Exchange programme bursary.
- EFIM Secretariat will organise coordination with the Tutor of the Hospital Centre selected to organise the exchange programme for the trainee.

OBJECTIVES



CENTER'S CRITERIA



The objective of this Programme is to promote short internships of one month among our European specialist training centers in Internal Medicine Units.

- The Exchange is open for Internal Medicine trainees in their third to fifth / sixth year.
- Each National Society will select one candidate per country. EFIM and FDIME will sponsor 10 scholarships of €1.000 which number could be increased at the discretion of and sponsored by the National Society.
- EFIM and FDIME will select the 10 best applications to participate in the programme.

Hospital should be able to provide an appropriate training in Internal Medicine.

- The Tutor should speak English with the resident quest.
- Clinical cases should be submitted and discussed in English.
- Help and support should be provided in finding accommodation.
- The Tutor must evaluate the final report of the trainee and submit a final evaluation to the EFIM Exchange Programme WG.
