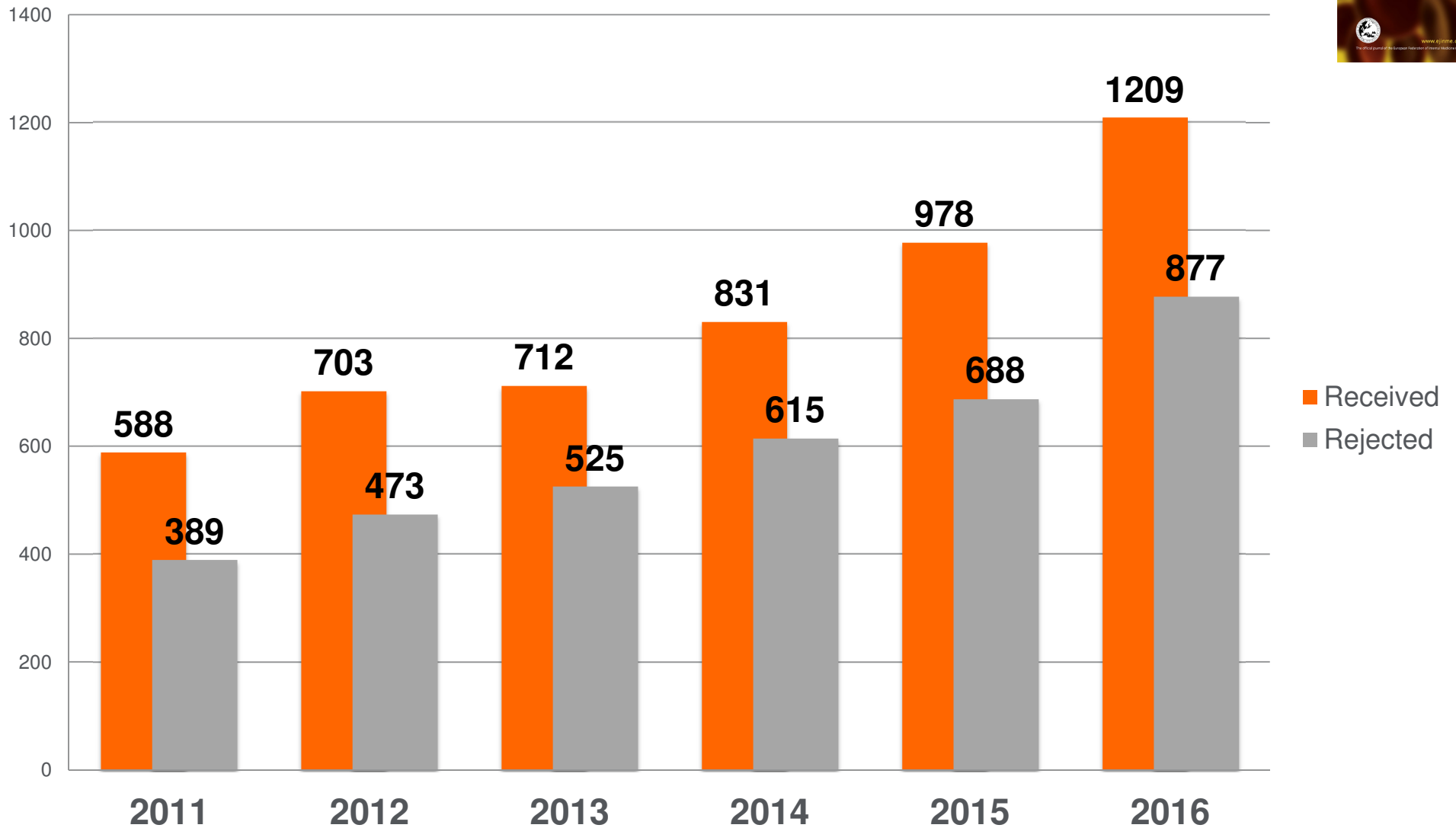

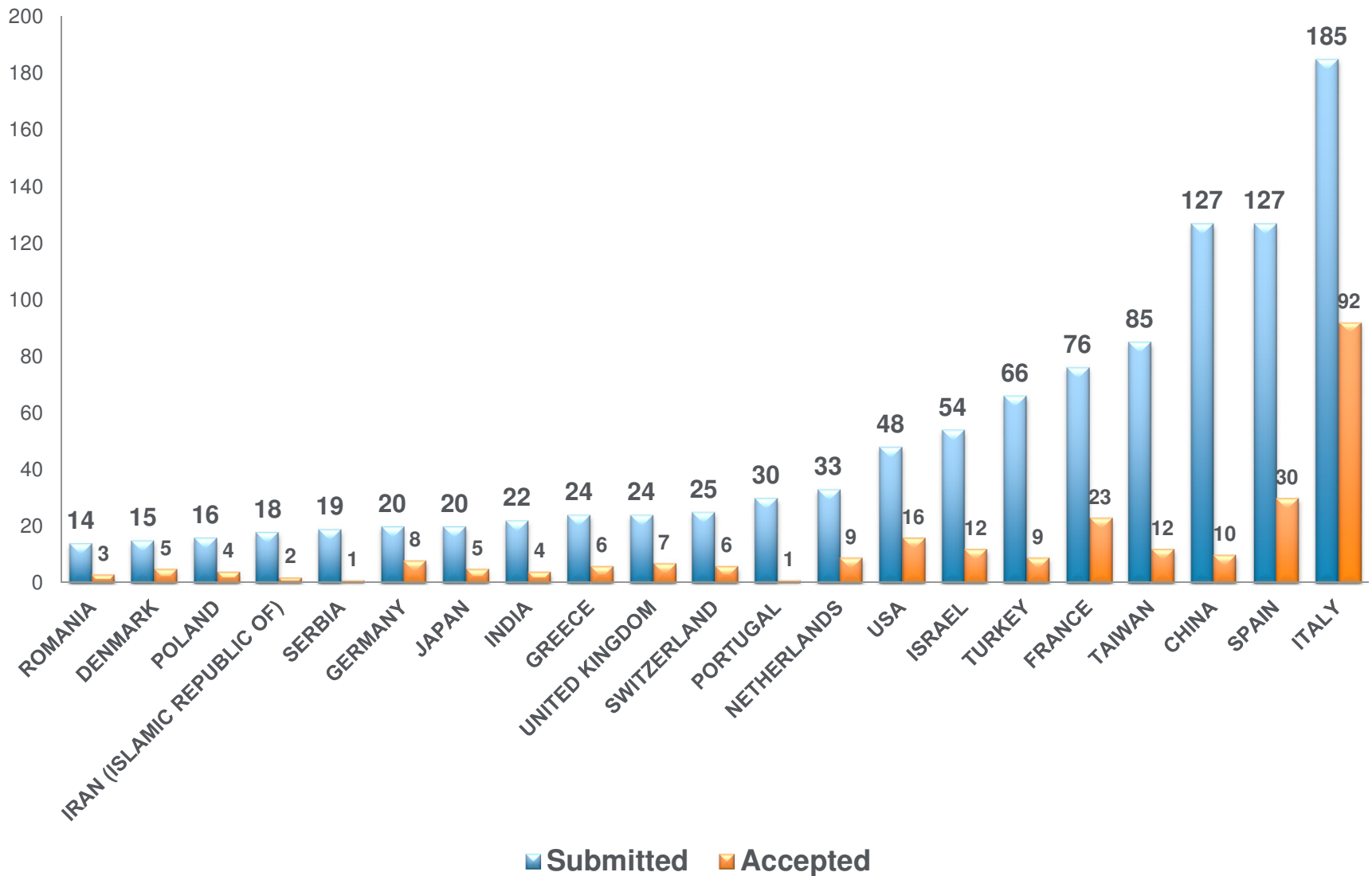
Submissions from 2011 to 2016



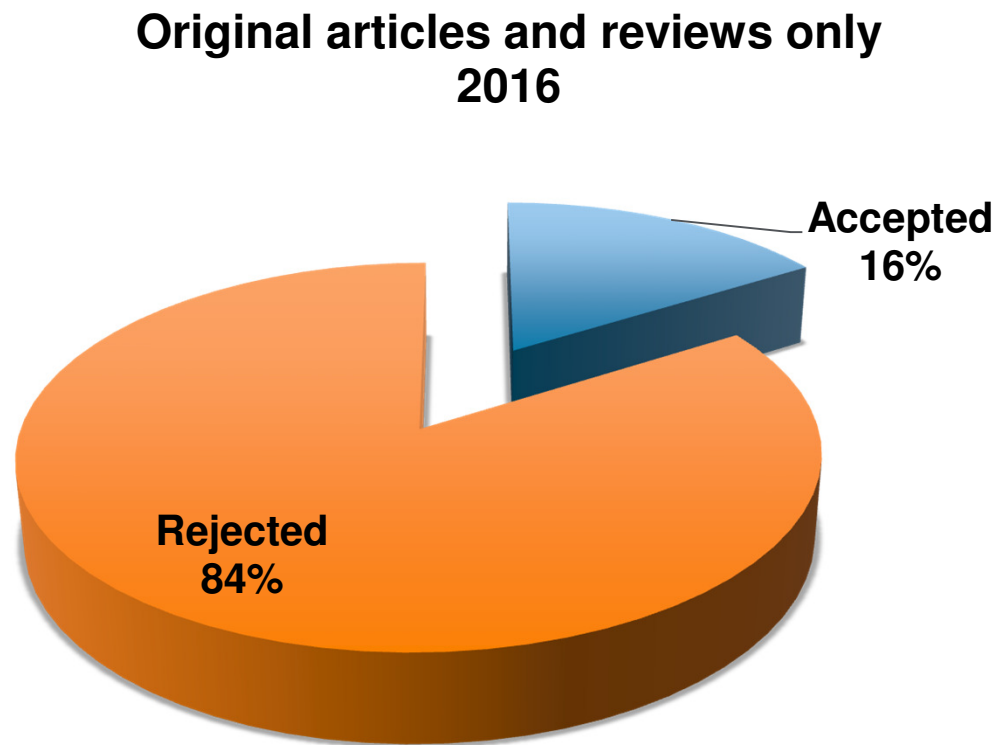
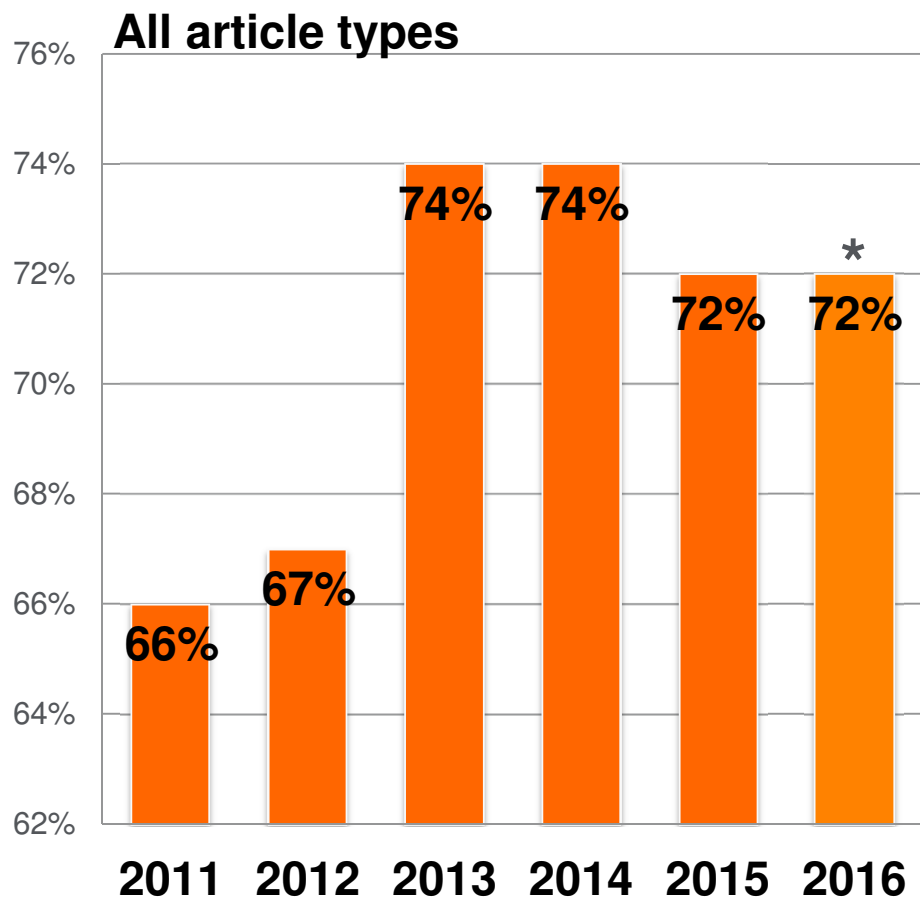

Rejection rates

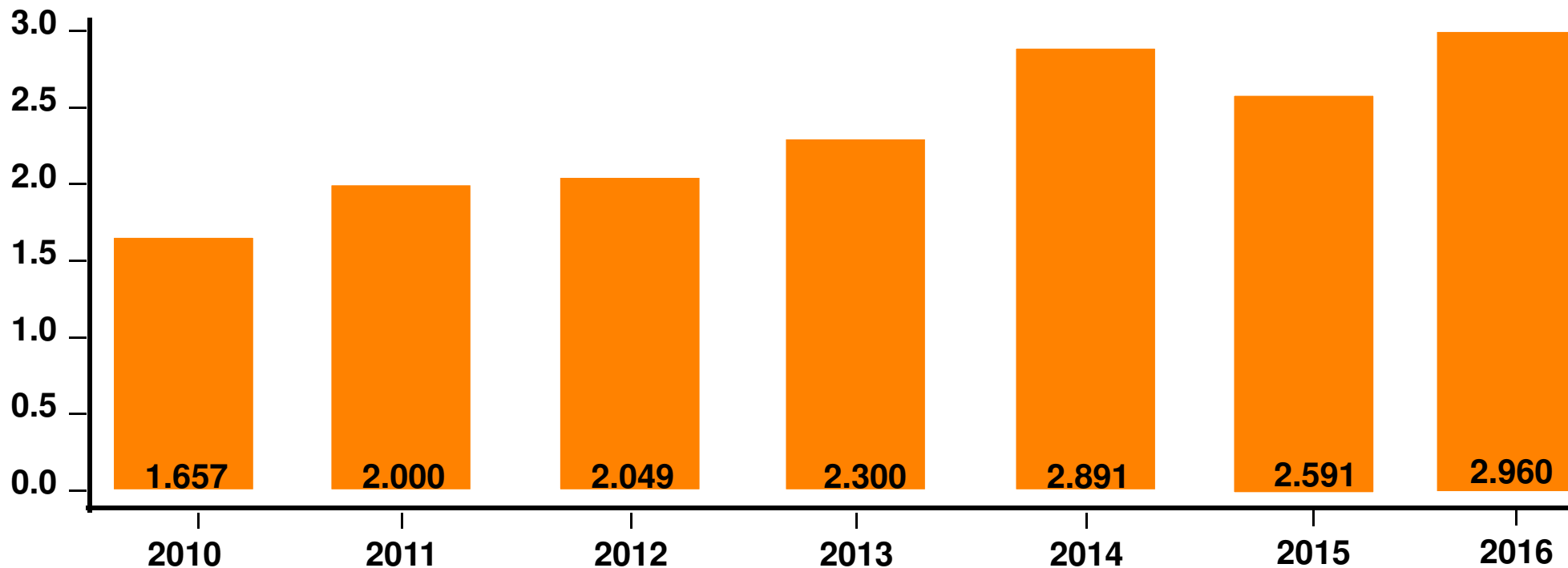
